



ABOUT GREEN SEAL

Green Seal is an independent, nonprofit organization that encourages the purchase and use of environmentally responsible products and services. It awards its Green Seal of approval to products that cause significantly less harm to the environment than similar products.

Green Seal sets an environmental standard for a category through an open, collaborative, process. Our study of a category takes a life cycle approach including material extraction, manufacturing, use and ultimate recycling or disposal. All Green Seal standards also have a performance requirement that a product work at least as well as others in its class. Standards are drafted with widespread input from industry, government, academia and the public. They are then broadly circulated for comment among manufacturers, trade associations, universities, environmental and consumer groups, government officials and the public. The final standard is published following written review of the comments. A formal appeal mechanism is available. As a result of this overall process Green Seal standards are totally transparent.

Green Seal's realistic standards are leadership standards that can be met by the top echelon of a product category. They are periodically review and updated to incorporate advances in technology.

The Green Seal assures consumers that certified products have been thoroughly tested, work well and are among the most environmentally responsible ones available. Products are Green Seal certified only after rigorous testing and evaluation including plant visits. To date over 300 products have been awarded the Green Seal including Safety-Kleen motor oil, Andersen windows, Sherwin-Williams paint, Carrier air conditioners, Mohawk paper, Panasonic heat pumps and Trane chillers. Certified products are monitored annually to ensure continued compliance with Green Seal standards.

Green Seal's Environmental Partners Program helps businesses, government agencies, and other organizations make environmentally responsible purchases. Participants receive a copy of the *Office Green Buying Guide* and monthly copies of *Choose Green Reports*. The *Choose Green Reports* make it easy to act on environmental concerns by recommending specific brands and models environmentally responsible products and telling where to buy them. In return, Environmental Partners commit to a green procurement policy and to maintaining a recycling system.

Green Seal has an extensive outreach program to promote environmentally responsible products including articles, press releases and public service announcements. Green Seal also works to encourage environmentally responsible purchasing in the lodging industry through the American Hotel & Motel Association, with 18 leading television and movie studios through the Environmental Media Association and with government bodies including the U.S. Postal Service and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
